Goal

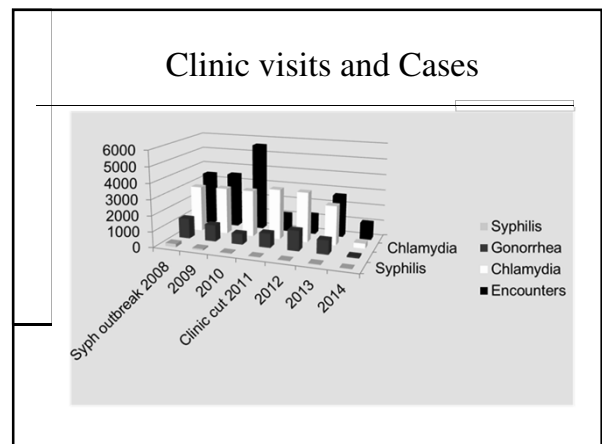
To improve the health status of Genesee County residents, with particular attention to eliminating racial, social, and economic inequities and using prevention and intervention strategies that target underlying causes.

Top Ten Community Priorities

#8 Promote Healthy Sexuality- *Making wise and informed choices, taking care of your reproductive health and accepting and expressing your sexual identity are all vital to staying sexually healthy throughout your life. Promoting awareness of healthy sexuality means encouraging communication about feelings and values, family planning, condom use and knowing HIV and STD status through routine testing*

STD Clinic

- Provides urine testing for trich, gonorrhea, chlamydia
- Blood test for syphilis
- Assistance with identifying risky behaviors and developing a risk reduction plan
- Rapid HIV testing



WHY Testing Partnerships?

- We no longer have the money and staffing to do it ourselves
- People have different points of entry into care and need access where they are
- Working with partners gives us further reach while not decentralizing our limited resources

Why These Partners?

Medical Providers

- Use the GCHD encounter and consent form
 - Collect demographic, insurance & billing
 - Bring specimens to GCHD
- Results are sent to the provider
 - Provider has been given the GCHD STD treatment protocols
 - Meds & Med logs are given to the provider
 - Provider treats according to our protocols and lets us know when needing more meds and fills out and submits V76

CBO Process

- Fills out our encounter and consent forms collecting demographics and insurance information and delivers specimen to GCHD
- Informs client that tests are being run through the GCHD and any follow up on testing will be done by GCHD
- GCHD completes any follow up and V76 reporting
